The 'Īao Renaissance Foundation is a school-wide positive reinforcement program, aimed to recognize student academic achievement, enhance and grow student relationships, and promote positive character traits.

The 'Īao Renaissance Program is for all students in 6th through 8th grade and offers incentives and rewards for academic excellence, attendance, and behavior. At the end of each quarter, our Renaissance Team of teachers checks grades, attendance records, and disciplinary reports to see which students are eligible based on the following criteria:

Gold Card: Straight A's & nothing below. Good Attendance, No Discipline Referrals/Detention/Suspensions.

Maroon Card: A's & B's & nothing below. Good Attendance, No Discipline Referrals/Detention/Suspensions.

White Card: A's/B's/C's & nothing below. Good Attendance, No Discipline Referrals/Detention/Suspensions.

Students must also volunteer a minimum of 3 hours of community or school service each quarter.

This year, we had 256 students at 'Īao Intermediate School participated in our Renaissance Program. Renaissance Scholars have stepped up in numerous ways. Students have gone out of their way, by participating in our Cookie Corner fundraiser and raised a little over \$12,000 and completed approximately 2,302 hours of community service.

We would like to recognize many volunteers, the 'Īao School faculty, the parents, family, businesses, and friends for the countless volunteer hours you have provided. The Renaissance program continues to thrive ready and it's ready to tackle another successful year.

The Renaissance Program

Renaissance was developed in 1984 by Larry Biddle at Conway High School in South Carolina and has been implemented in over 1,800 schools across the nation. Renaissance is a partnership between business and education which brings ideas and people together to find ways for our children to experience the true joy of learning and to recognize educators as dedicated and valued professionals.

Results have been positive and many schools report improvements in school climate, attendance, student discipline, as well as reduction of juvenile crimes in school and in the community. Renaissance is not so much a program as it is an attitude to excel, to do well in school, and to have pride in one's overall accomplishments.

'Īao School's Mission, Goals and Plans

The mission of the **'Īao School Renaissance Foundation** is to help the school promote and achieve academic excellence, in effect, to create a renaissance in education.

"The purpose of our organization primary mission is to help the school promote excellence and contribution to their community, state and nation. The purpose of the of the academic program is to equip our student with knowledge, skills, attitudes and values they need to make responsible decisions to their own lives. Education should result in individual self-fulfillment as well as enabling students to contribute to their community, State and nation. Our goal is to instill pride, to strengthen basic skills and to inspire a positive attitude toward learning and excelling which should carry over to their adult lives. Our students are the future of our community."

'Īao School will implement the concepts of Renaissance to promote academic excellence in our students. The school will focus on four major areas to begin the process of self-improvement:

- Goal 1 To have students maintain a Grade Point Average (GPA) of a 2.0 or above with no "D's" or "F's".**
- Goal 2 To have no Disciplinary Referrals. No class A, B, C offense and no suspensions.**
- Goal 3 To promote community service of our students, a minimum of 3 hours per Quarter.**

'Īao School Renaissance Foundation is committed to recognizing further academic excellence for the school year. This will be done by raising the expectations for ourselves and for our students and by providing awards for those achieving higher levels of performance.

This "Renaissance" will be realized by taking a business approach to improve academic performance. American businesses and our free-market system have proven to the world that people who are motivated perform and take great pride in the development of their skills.

Partners in Excellence is a partnership between the business community and **'Īao School** to recognize students for their academic accomplishments by providing positive tangible incentives to encourage students to reach for greater levels of academic achievement.

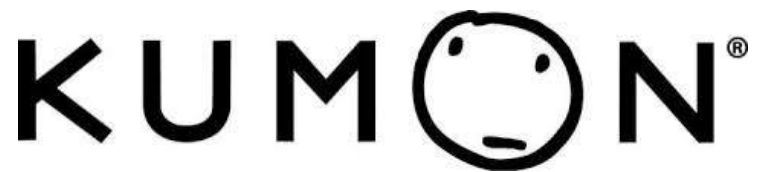

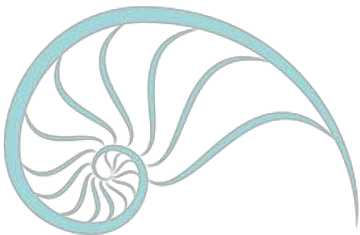
